Board Highlights for January 25, 2010

1. The Advancement Committee is involved in planning a series of enrollment-related promotional events, highlighted by a 4K-12 Open House on Saturday, January 30th. We will be cross-promoting with Randolph Christian to zip codes in a 30-mile radius
2. The Board reviewed the staff intention slips which have been returned regarding plans for the 2010.2011 school year.
3. CWC is looking for two host families for international students for the 2010.2011 school year from South Korea or the Far East who are looking for a Christian school in the states where they can receive a biblically-based education.
4. A new policy and procedure for electing the Board President was approved. In addition, the outgoing Board President will remain a non-voting member of the Board on an advisory role through October of the following year.
5. Gary De Jager was chosen as the president-elect of the CWC Board for the 2010.2011 school year.
6. Scott De Young presented an update on the work of the Building Expansion Leadership Team and the work of the sub-groups in the areas of Building Design and Capital Fundraising. The BELT's work continues to be in the areas of vision-building and feasibility/readiness work.
7. The Board reaffirmed the progress of the BELT and approved an extension of their work, including an informational meeting for the full society scheduled for April 30th.
8. Preliminary budgeting continues for next year's budget. God's blessings continue to be felt.
9. Technology Committee received monies from the Hicks Grant which have been designated toward completing the SmartBoard project and towards other Technology needs.
10. Investigation has begun to a Net Book/1:1 laptop program proposal.
