Board Highlights for November 2009*

1. Approval was given to being a Senior Retreat in the fall of 2010 in place of the Senior Class trip that typically occurs in the spring of the year. This would be an overnight spiritual leadership retreat to build community and leadership.
2. Approval was given to a new Wellness Policy
3. The Education Committee shared that they will be identifying goals in the review of curriculum and its overall scope.
4. Finance Committee reported that received \$94,000 from the Auction Committee as proceeds from this year's event, exceeding the budget amount of \$90,000.
5. Through the first four months of the year, finances appear to be in excellent shape.
6. The Board reflected on their Board Retreat which was held on Saturday, November 14th. Much of it focused on managing a transition from being management-minded to a governance-minded approach to Board leadership and operation.
