The Crusader Card Sale will continue through Friday, Oct. 6th. Please return all money collected and unsold cards to Mr. Hofman on or before that date. Here are some frequently asked questions about Crusader Cards:

1. What is a Crusader Card?

It is a discount card used at local businesses for buy one/get one offers or a percent off.

2. Where can I get Crusader Cards?

Mr. Hofman has the cards and keeps track of how many you have sold. See him before, during, or after school.

3. I've sold my cards. Now what?

Return the money you have collected to Mr. Hofman. He will keep track of the money you have in your personal account (60% of your gross sales is available in your account.) Please remember to return unsold cards as well.

4. What can that money be used for?

The funds can be used to cover athletic fees (\$50/year for middle school; \$75/season for high school), team gear (for example, basketball warm-up shirts), and Crusader duffel bags. The money may NOT be used to purchase items from the Crusader Closet.

5. How do I know if I have money left in my account?

Ask Mr. Hofman, or send him a quick email.

6. Does the money in my account roll over to next year?

No.

7. Should I keep selling if my "needs" for this year are met?

Absolutely! If you do, the Athletic Fund at CWC continues to grow – and this is a benefit for ALL of our athletes. You will probably also find it easier to sell cards in the coming years if you establish "customers" this year. If 50 kids sold 20 cards each, the Booster Club would raise \$10,000 and be in great position to impact our kids in so many positive ways!!
