Home Practice

- Bible:** This week we'll finish up our study on Joseph. Study guide comes home today. Unit test on Wednesday.
- Memory Verse:** None this week
- Phonics:** Students will gain more practice with short e. Students will also be introduced to initial consonant blends, such as bl, cr, pl, etc. Phonic readers this week are ***Jeff the Cat; Ted and Fran;*** and ***The Sleds.*** Spelling words include ***men, red, step, ten, net, leg, jet, sled, wet, bed, saw, small, your.***
- Reading:** The concept this week is **main idea**. The reading story coming home is ***Get the Egg!*** There are no vocabulary words.
- Math:** Students will learn to **count back, use a number line, draw a picture, and compare in order to subtract.**
- Grammar:** Students will learn that **interrogative sentences** ask something.
- Writing:** Students will write a **realistic story while incorporating sequence and time order.**
- Social Studies** Students will learn more about **our country**. Students will also discover that there are different **land and water formations**.
- Science:** We are studying **how plants grow and change, and how plants make seeds.**
- Handwriting** Students will learn the strokes to **letter Ee.**
