Home Practice

Bible: This week our studies include **Joseph the Prisoner, Pharaoh's Dream, and Joseph's Brothers' First Visit.**

Memory Verse:

Phonics: Students will learn inflected endings –s and –ing. Phonic readers this week are ***Big Jobs; Packing Bags;*** and ***Rocking and Kicking.*** Spelling words include ***sit, sits, win, wins, fit, fits, hit, hits, nap, naps, too, four, five, this, her.***

Reading: The concept this week is **main idea**. The reading story coming home is **A Fox and a Kit.** Vocabulary words : ***animals, dinner, watch*** (verb form).

Math: Students will learn **different ways to add.**

Grammar: Students will learn that **declarative sentences** tell something.

Writing: Students will write a **personal narrative.**

Social Studies Students will learn about **our country.**
